Create GenAl Policy for Schools: 4 steps

REFLECT & DIAGNOSE

- Reflect about the impact of GenAl in school by bringing together teachers and leaders.
- Diagnose teachers training needs about GenAl.
- Raise awareness with an event open to the school community. Warness A Services
- GenAl literacy workshops for teachers.

CREATE & COLLABORATE

- Define a team of teachers and leaders responsible for creating the first draft for the GenAl policy.
- Collaborate with cross-curricular teachers to review and contribute to the proposal for the use of GenAl in the school.
 - GenAl workshops for teachers.

MONITOR & ASSESS

- Monitor the implementation of GenAl policy in school.
- Assess policy implementation, by team of teachers/leaders, measuring success and collecting feedback.
- Update and improve GenAl policy.
- Raise awareness with an event open to the school community.
- GenAl literacy workshops for teachers, students, caregivers.

APROVE & IMPLEMENT

- Approve the GenAl policy in school, with consensus from representatives of teachers, students and caregivers.
- Update school's internal regulations to comply with the approved GenAl policy.
- Implement the GenAl policy and support teachers in the process.
- GenAl workshops for teachers.
